

Two important member ID card changes coming in January 2022 December 2021

Providers and Office Staff:

We have two important changes coming to our 2022 member ID cards. Please read this information carefully and share it with anyone in your office who needs it.

- 1. ALL True Health New Mexico members will receive new ID cards for 2022. This is due to new, federally mandated information that must be printed on each card.
- 2. True Health New Mexico's individual and family *on-exchange members*, who have a member ID prefix of 000, will have *new group and subscriber ID numbers* on their cards.

Here's what you need to know:

- It is crucial for all our contracted providers to ensure they have the most current ID cards for their True Health New Mexico patients.
 - When these patients check in at your facility, please make a copy of their current ID cards and update your billing systems to avoid claim denials.
- Unless otherwise contractually allowed, you will have 90 days from the date of service to file any claims under the **2021** ID card.
- True Health New Mexico will update its *Claims and Eligibility Reference Guide* and *Provider Handbook* in January 2022 with this information. You can find both documents at <u>https://www.truehealthnewmexico.com/providers/</u>.
- True Health New Mexico has educated its on-exchange individual and family plan members about this change. We have reminded them to destroy their old cards and start using their new cards beginning January 2022.
