In addition, your True Health New Mexico plan offers many generic drugs for nine chronic conditions at a \$0 copay. This benefit makes it easier for you to continue taking medications that help you stay well.

**\$0** Copayments for Behavioral Health Office Visits: Whether you are dealing with a crisis or just need a counselor to talk to, our network offers access to many behavioral health providers. Also, your plan offers a \$0 copay for outpatient behavioral health visits, including substance-abuse visits.

We offer a supplemental network called MultiPlan that you can access if you are traveling outside of New Mexico and need emergency care. When you visit a MultiPlan-contracted provider, you can avoid being balance-billed for these services.
