1. **Welcome and Call to Order – Melissa Gutierrez**

Ms. Gutierrez welcomed everyone and called the meeting to order at 2:09 p.m. She reviewed meeting procedures using the Zoom application.

3. **APPROVAL OF AGENDA**

MOTION Chair Johnson called for a motion to approve the Agenda. Mr. Benavidez so moved, seconded by Mr. York. There being no discussion or opposition, the Agenda was approved.

4. **Vendor recommendation, discussion and vote for SLCGP Project 2 (Action Item)
Cybersecurity Risk Assessment (NCSR Completion Support) – 22 applicants**

Mr. Benavidez stated that on behalf of the Procurement and Engagement Subcommittees he would like to bring forward discussion regarding recommendations for two vendors, which they felt they could meet the project needs in the timeline required, those vendors being Deloitte and Datapoint. Mr. Benavidez shared that the Committee could not reach a unanimous agreement between the two; that there were certain elements of each vendor which they liked and gave details of these elements. He then stated that the Subcommittee(s) had decided to bring these recommendations to the full Committee for a decision, given the different elements to be considered. He added that their bids were relatively close with Deloitte's being approximately \$284 thousand and Datapoint slightly lower at \$220 thousand, with the budget for this project being \$500 thousand.

Chair Johnson thanked Mr. Benavidez for this information.

Discussion of the elements described by Mr. Benavidez and the advantages/disadvantages of each vendor ensued with Chair Johnson, Mr. Presley, Mr. Sambandam, Mr. York, Mr. Benavidez, Ms. Chacon, Ms. Gutierrez, and Dr. Mukkamala providing input. This discussion focused primarily on the factors of local versus non-local vendor, capacity to meet timelines and provide support without incurring additional costs above bid amount, ability to scale and the ability to provide dedicated assistance and hands-on support for local entities.

MOTION: Subsequent to the above discussion Chair Johnson called for a motion to select Deloitte as the vendor for the SLCGP Project 2 – Cybersecurity Risk Assessment (NCSR Completion Support). Mr. Presley so moved, seconded by Dr. Mukkamala. Roll call vote was conducted by Ms. Gutierrez. The motion passed unanimously and Deloitte was approved as the vendor for this project.

Chair Johnson encouraged support of Datapoint as a local vendor for future opportunities.

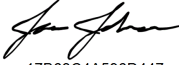
5. Public Comment
