## **Cybersecurity Planning Committee and Cybersecurity Advisory Committee**

### **Attachment**

OCS is in the process of publishing a set of Policy Templates / Tools for Local Governments and Educational Institutions within the State of New Mexico. A decision between NIST SP 800-171 Revision 2 and Revision 3 as the baseline for this set of policy tools needs to be made. Both Revisions have strong cases, but a decision needs to be made that will influence alignment between two opposing factors.

- NIST SP 800-171 (Revision 2): Revision 2 aligns with Cybersecurity Maturity Model Certification (CMMC) and is the foundation for CMMC Certification which will require Third Part Certification beginning November 10, 2026.
  - CMMC is expected to transition from NIST SP 800-171 Rev. 2 to Rev. 3 through future DoD rulemaking, as the current CMMC rule relies on Rev. 2. While Rev. 3 was released in May 2024, the DoD issued a class deviation to continue using Rev. 2 for existing contracts, allowing time for industry transition. It is expected to take “considerable time” before this transition takes place.
- NIST SP 800-171 (Revision 3): Revision 3 aligns with NIST SP 800-53 (rev 5) and CSF 2.0 which is the State of New Mexico’s standard for cybersecurity Policy, Standards, and Controls for State Agencies.
  - While there is a loose mapping between Rev 2 and Rev 3 policies, the two revisions are NOT compatible with each other. NIST recommends that Organizations completely overhaul their Rev 2 policy, standards, and controls to meet Rev 3 compliance requirements.
