# Purpose of Application

The application aims to achieve three key objectives.

**Evidence-based Assessment** 

• Enable the review team and OBAE staff to make an evidence-based assessment regarding those projects that offer the greatest potential to achieve program objectives and thus warrant an award.

Incentivizes Awardee Alignment with Program Design • The application (along with the scoring framework) directs applicants to develop a comprehensive strategy and implementation plan that achieves the program objectives.

Accountability via Award Agreement

 The application becomes part of the Award Agreement; the grantee (awardee) is subject to all the commitments made in the application (e.g., serving the project areas, offering the services at listed prices, deploying the technology type, etc.)

The application comprises of 16 sections and an Appendix.

#### **Key Themes**

- Components are consistent with a comprehensive broadband business plan
  - Technology specifications
  - Network design
  - Market feasibility
  - Financial forecasts
  - Go-to-market strategy
  - Community impact
- Content often required by investors, board members, project partner, etc.
- Major gaps should make an applicant think twice about their readiness to implement a network that can be technically and financially sustainable

# Application Submission via Intake System

• An application in-take system will be ready in a few weeks to enable the efficient filing of applications.

#### Overview

- Intake system enable applicants to directly upload the application and attachments.
- Serve as a tool to correspond with applicants.
- Allows for two representatives to receive correspondence:
  - Primary individual who attests to the accuracy of the application
  - Secondary contact who may be providing project and/or administrative support
- Tool will be ready in the coming weeks.

### Content Development

- Complete all sections of the fillable PDF and submit the required attachments.
- Remember the "3 C's": comprehensiveness, clarity, and credibility.
- Strong applications
   provide great detail which
   is easy to understand and
   backed with analysis and
   assertions grounded in
   facts and evidence.
- Understand the scoring framework and develop a genuine plan around those parameters.

### **External Support**

- Hire a 3<sup>rd</sup> party (firm or individual) to work on sections which require expertise not available internally (e.g., network design, market feasibility, financial forecasts).
- Tap unexpected sources for support (e.g.., equipment vendors)
- Review myriad of online resources and best practices.
