Service Highlight:

PROPERLY STORING SERVICE RECORDS

As an EOR it is important to keep records that show that services have been provided. EORs must keep records for a minimum of six (6) years from the first date of service.

Important documents to keep include but are not limited to:

- Approved SSP and Budget
- Copies of signed Employee and Vendor Agreements
- Copies of invoices, VPRs, mileage sheets, or timesheets
- Receipts for goods purchased
- Daily progress notes
- Attendance logs

These documents are needed to complete EOR responsibilities and may also be requested by the Health Care Authority (HCA) Mi Via/Medical Assistance Division (MAD) or Developmental Disabilities and Support Division (DDSD) during program audits. In addition, the EOR must protect employee's privacy and confidentiality. The EOR must have a secure place to store paper and electronic files and keep them available in case they are audited.



Developmental Disabilities and Support Division (DDSD) and Advisory Council on Quality (ACQ)

The Advisory Council on Quality Supports for People with Intellectual/Developmental Disabilities (ACQ) guides DDSD on the systems guiding the running of services and supports that help people with IDD of all ages and their families to be fully included in New Mexico communities. The duties and responsibilities of the ACQ includes, but is not limited to the following:

- Conduct meetings every other month.
- Advise and assist the Department in reviewing outcomes regarding the quality assurance system for people with I/DD and their support networks.
- Provide information and feedback about service availability and current needs with regard to people with I/DD and their support networks.
- Participate in any statewide needs assessment processes.
- Recommend priorities for the development, modification, and expansion of services to meet the needs of people with I/DD.
- Advise and assist the Division in planning for services to people with I/DD.
- Promote collaboration efforts among state agencies and community-based programs serving people with I/DD.
- Advocate for system change to improve on the quality of services addressing the specialized and individual needs of people with I/DD; and
- Advise the Division on policy changes and policy development.

The next public ACQ meeting will be held 8/8/2024 at 9am-1pm via Zoom.

Fun easy recipes:

Strawberry Lime Smoothies

Total time to make: 5 minutes

Makes: 3 servings

Ingredients:

- 1 cup strawberry yogurt
- 1/2 cup 2% milk
- 2 to 4 tablespoons lime juice
- 2 tablespoons honey
- 1/4 teaspoon ground cinnamon
- 2 cups fresh strawberries, hulled

Directions:

- 1. Put all ingredients in a covered blender.
- 2. Blend until smooth.

Crunchy Granola Pretzel Sticks

Total time to make: 25 minutes

Makes: 2 dozen

Ingredients:

- 1 package (12 ounces) dark chocolate chips
- 24 pretzel rods
- 1 cup granola without raisins
- Wax paper

Directions:

- 1. In a microwave, melt chocolate chips in a 2cup glass measuring cup.
- 2. Stir until smooth.
- 3. Pour into only 1 side of a large shallow dish.
- 4. Roll the top half of each pretzel into chocolate.
- 5. Allow excess chocolate coating to drip off.
- 6. Sprinkle pretzels with granola.
- 7. Place on waxed paper until set.
- 8. Store in an airtight container.
