

Service Highlights:

In-home living supports (IHLS):

IHLS is related to the participant's qualifying condition or disability. This allows a participant to live in their own home. Services must be given in the residence owned or leased by the participant. Service coordination and nursing services are not part of IHLS.

- IHLS are given in the participant's own home.
- IHLS is individually made to show or improve home living skills.
- IHLS addresses health and safety.
- IHLS gives help with activities of daily living.
- IHLS helps with learning, building, or holding on to independent living skills.
- IHLS is given on a normal basis for at least four or more hours per day. One or more days per week. This may be up to 24 hours per day as stated in the participant's Service and Support Plan (SSP).
- Participant's getting IHLS must be at least 18 years of age.
- Participants cannot use the following because they are the same as IHLS:
 - Homemaker
 - Direct support home health aide services
 - o Respite
- IHLS is NOT given in residences owned or leased by a provider agency. Unless the participant has a lease or other legal protection in place for that residence.

W-2 tax information for 2024

- All 2024 W-2 forms must be mailed to employees by January 31, 2025
- Call the Consolidated Customer Service Center (CCSC) at 1-800-283-4465 if you have not received your 2024 W-2 by February 15, 2025
- Make sure Conduent has your current mailing address
- Updates to your address must be made by 12/31/2024
- To update any of your information:
 - Complete a <u>Change of Information</u> <u>Form</u>
 - Submit this form to docprocesing@conduent.com

Timely-Filing Requirements

In New Mexico, there is a ninety (90) calendar day limit for filing:

- Timesheets
- Vendor Payment Request forms (VPR)
- Invoices

When timesheets, VPR or invoices are sent more than ninety (90) days after the service has been provided the following will happen:

- Payment will be denied.
- Timesheets, VPR's and/or invoices will be returned to the approved support person or EOR through the Return to Participant (RTP) process.
- The first date of service of a claim is when the ninety (90) day clock will start.
- Please reach out to your consultant for more help.

Fun easy recipes:

Pie Crust Cookies

Total time to make: 50 minutes

Makes: 12 cookies

Ingredients:

- 1 premade pie crust
- all-purpose flour for dusting
- 1 large egg
- 1 teaspoon whole milk
- 2 tablespoons granulated sugar
- 3/4 teaspoon ground cinnamon
- 1/8 teaspoon kosher salt
- 1 1/2 tablespoons unsalted butter, melted and cooled

Directions:

- 1. Preheat oven to 375 degrees.
- 2. Line 2 large baking sheets with parchment paper.
- 3. Set baking sheets to the side.
- 4. Lightly flour a work area.
- 5. Roll out the premade pie crust to 1/8-inch thick on the lightly floured area.

- 6. Use cookie cutters to cut cookies from pie crust dough.
- 7. Place the cut-out cookies on the baking sheets half an inch apart.
- 8. Repeat the above steps with the left-over dough to make more cookies.
- 9. Mix the egg and milk together in a small bowl.
- 10. Brush the top of each cookie with the milk and egg mixture.
- 11. Mix the sugar, cinnamon and salt in a small bowl.
- 12. Sprinkle evenly over each cookie.
- 13. Place cookies in the preheated oven for 15 minutes or until the cookies are a golden brown.
- 14. When you carefully take the cookies out of the oven brush each cookie lightly with melted butter.
- 15. Let cookies cool for 5 minutes.
- 16. Eat cookies warm.
