



W-2 tax information for 2024

- All 2024 W-2 forms must be mailed to employees by January 31, 2025
- Call the Consolidated Customer Service Center (CCSC) at 1-800-283-4465 if you have not received your 2024 W-2 by February 15, 2025
- Make sure Conduent has your current mailing address
- Updates to your address must be made by 12/31/2024

See Something Say Something

If you or anyone else is suffering abuse, neglect, or exploitation (ANE) please say something. You, friends, or family **do not** have to live a life of abuse. Know what abuse is and who to report it to. In most cases you may remain anonymous.

"Abuse" including verbal abuse is knowingly, on purpose, and without basis causing:

- Physical pain
- Injury
- Mental hurt
- Sexual abuse

"Neglect" means the failure of the caretaker to provide basic needs of a person such as:

- Clothing
- Food
- Shelter
- Supervision
- Care for the physical
- Mental health of that person

Neglect causes or is likely to cause harm to a person.

"Exploitation" means an unfair or unacceptable use of a person's money or property for another person's profit or gain, financial, or otherwise.

Some people are to report suspected abuse because they are:

- Afraid they are wrong.
- They might be causing trouble.
- That it's none of their business.

In New Mexico, the law requires you to report abuse ANY TIME you suspect or know about any kind of abuse. Most importantly, always do the right thing. Be your own hero or a loved one's hero.

Individual Directed Goods and Services

Individual Directed Goods and Services allows a Mi Via participant to buy a good or service that they need.

Such as:

- Equipment.
- Supplies.
- Services.

Goods or service asked for must be:

- Tied to the participant's disability.
- Help with participant's own safety and health.
- Helps the participant gain more freedom.
- Helps participants with activities of daily living.

Items a person without a disability would have to pay for are not covered by Mi Via.

Such as but not limited to:

- Female hygiene products.
- Gaming computer.
- A cell phone for another person.

Your consultant will help you make this goal to choose the goods and services allowed through Mi Via.

Fun easy recipes:

Homemade Applesauce

Makes about 3 cups

Ingredients:

- 7 medium apples
- ½ cup apple juice or water
- ½ cup sugar or honey, optional
- ½ teaspoon ground cinnamon, optional

Directions:

- 1. Peel apples.
- 2. Remove the middle of the apple where the apple seeds are.
- 3. Cut the apples into bite-sized chunks.
- 4. Put the apples into a medium saucepan.
- 5. Add the juice or water, sugar or honey and cinnamon.
- 6. Bring to a boil over medium-high heat.
- 7. Reduce heat to low.
- 8. Cover and simmer for 15 to 20 minutes.
- 9. Stir often, until the apples are tender.

White Chocolate Chex Mix

Total time to make: 30 minutes.

Ingredients:

- 5 cups of Cheerios
- 5 cups of Corn Chex
- 2 cups salted peanuts
- 1 pound chocolate M&M's
- 1 package (10 ounces) mini pretzels
- 2 packages (12 ounces each) white baking chips
- 3 tablespoons canola oil

Directions:

- 1. In a large bowl, combine Cheerios, Corn Chex, peanuts, M&M's and mini pretzels.
- 2. In a microwave safe bowl combine white backing chips and canola oil.
- 3. Place bowl of white baking chip and oil in the microwave for 1 minute.
- 4. Stir and microwave on high for 5 seconds.
- 5. Pour white chocolate mixture over the cereal mixture.
- Mix well.
- 7. Spread the mixture onto 3 waxed paper lined backing sheets.
- 8. Let cool.
- 9. Break apart and store in an airtight container.
