

## Declaration of Braden Anderson

I, Braden Anderson, declare under penalty of perjury that the following is true and correct to the best of my knowledge:

1. I am employed by the New Mexico Health Care Authority (HCA), in the Division of Health Improvement. My current title is "Senior Business Operations Analyst and Website Specialist", which I began in this official capacity on Nov. 8th, 2025.
2. In my official capacity, I retrieved and processed the video recordings contained herein. These recordings are part of HCA/DHI's investigative file and I retrieved them from our secured internal drives.
3. I altered the videos by adjusting the frame to more closely show the Subjects, compressing the videos for easier download and playback and by making the video file format more accessible to any device or playback format ONLY, using OpenShot Video Editor, an offline video processing platform. Other than frame size adjustment, file size optimization and file type conversion, no other alterations were made to the original videos.
4. These videos included no audio files. As such, no transcript was produced.
5. I uploaded the video files and transcript to a secure, password-protected page which I created using custom CSS and HTML code to password protect the content on the HCA website ([www.hca.nm.gov](http://www.hca.nm.gov)) which is maintained by HCA ITD. Access to the page is restricted to authorized personnel involved in the investigation and hearing process. To the best of my knowledge myself (Division of Health Improvement, HCA), Crystal Perdue (Program Operations Bureau, HCA) and Alex Corwin (Attorney, Office of General Counsel, HCA) are the only employees at HCA to have access to this page.
6. The video files and transcript have not been altered or edited in any way other than as described above since their retrieval and upload. They reflect the original content as recorded during the interview.
