Comicfy is an AI-powered tool that transforms everyday text into comic-style stories designed to support individuals with developmental disabilities.

In this session, Kush Shah, founder of Comicfy will showcase how the platform helps users to build social skills, understand routines, and increase independence through visual learning. The demo will walk through real examples of how families, therapists, and educators are using Comicfy to make learning more accessible, engaging, and effective.

The second presentation will be by Jennifer Anderson OTR/L from Sunburst Therapy & Wanda Robinson MS, CCC-SLP from Robinson Professional Services. They have collaborated for 17 years, focusing on functional assistive technology for environmental control and communication.

They will demonstrate Pictello, a visual storytelling application for Apple devices that gives users the ability to create interactive storybooks using photos, videos, text, and audio. It's particularly useful for individuals who benefit from visual aids and those support with social skills, sequencing, and organizational skills. Join us to learn about Pictello...!

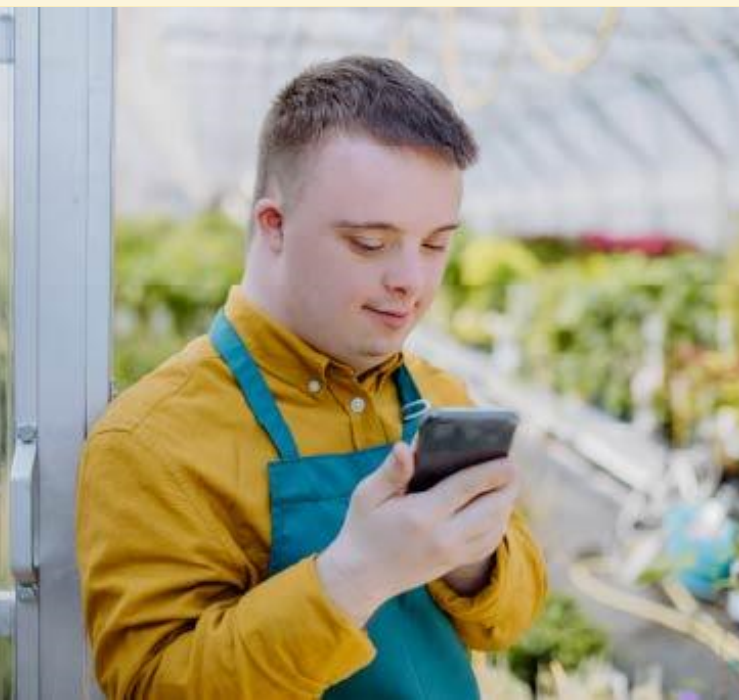
