## What Are ICF/IID Services?

Intermediate Care Facilities for Individuals with intellectual disabilities (ICF/IID) are residential facilities (usually for adults) that provide ongoing care, treatment, and rehabilitation services for people with intellectual disabilities. New Mexico ICF/IIDs are licensed by the state.



## **Services and Supports Include:**

- Personal Assistance 24/7
- Nursing, Dental, and Medical
- Speech Pathology and Audiology
- Social Services
- Pharmacy Services & Medication Assistance
- Dietician/Food Service
- Recreation/Activities

## **Eligibility for ICF/IID Placement**

Individuals who may be eligible for ICF/IID placement must:

- 1. Have a qualifying intellectual or developmental disability
- 2. Apply for Home and Community
  Based Services (HCBS) via
  Developmental Disabilities Waiver
  Application through the New Mexico
  Health Care Authority Developmental
  Disabilities Supports Division (DDSD)
  website at https://www.hca.nm.gov/
  pre-service-intake-bureau/ and
  receive a "Yes Match" letter.
- \*If you are receiving this flyer along with a Yes Match letter, it means you have completed the first two tasks.
- 3. Apply and meet medical and financial eligibility through the New Mexico Health Care Authority Income Support Division (ISD) website https://yes.nm.gov.
