

Although Shaynna is a single mom, we always try to work together to make things work for scheduling and ensuring that Shaynna stays healthy and supported because we know raising a child is not easy.

Over the years, we have all grown and learned from each other. With each transition in life for our daughter, something new or unexpected occurs, but Shaynna is very committed and follows through for the care that our daughter needs at the time. We fully appreciate her knowledge of medications and the importance of how they can affect our daughter's disposition, and the therapies that can support her. She is in tune with our daughter's moods and disposition at any time. She knows when to interact directly, or step back and give her space. She does all this with respect and trustworthiness. Including when these transitions involve family dynamics such as a significant change or family member health matters that sometime directly impacts Shaynna and our daughter.

### Fun easy recipes:

#### **Peanut Butter Granola Pinwheels**

Makes 10 pinwheels

Total time to make: 10 minutes

#### Ingredients:

- 4 tablespoons creamy peanut butter
- 2 flour tortillas (8 inches)
- 2 teaspoons of honey
- 1/2 cup granola without raisins

### Directions:

- 1. Spread peanut butter on each tortilla
- 2. Drizzle with honey
- 3. Sprinkle granola
- 4. Roll tortilla up
- 5. Cut into slices.

### Frozen Berry & Yogurt Swirls

Makes 10 pops

Total time to make: 15 minutes

### Ingredients:

- 10 plastic or paper cups (3 ounces each)
- 2-3/4 cups fat-free honey Greek yogurt
- 1 cup mixed fresh berries
- 1/4 cup of water
- 2 tablespoons sugar
- 10 wooden pop sticks

#### Directions:

- 1. Fill each cup with 1/4 cup yogurt.
- 2. Place berries, water and sugar in a food processor
- 3. Pulse until berries are finely chopped.
- 4. Spoon 1-1/2 tablespoons of berry mixture into each cup.
- 5. Stir gently with a pop stick to swirl.
- 6. Cover cups with foil/
- 7. Insert a pop stick through the foil.
- 8. Freeze until it is firm.
