

# MI VIA VENDOR STAKEHOLDER COMMITTEE MINUTES

## Discussion

No formal agenda was provided.

Angelique inquired if everyone had received the recurring meeting invites. Continue to use the link in your calendar invites. Next meeting is 12/10/24. Please let Angelique know if you are not receiving the invites via email. Please add other interested people in our group if they are not added.

### **Billing issues:**

Issues with billing were discussed. Angelique shared that Alta Mira continues to have an issue with submitted billing and vendor packets using the docprocessing email. Due to this issue, all billing documentation needs to be printed and handdelivered to Conduent. Angelique encourages everyone to keep an eye on what they send into Conduent and ensure their documentation is being processed and paid. Tracy noted that on the DDW side, they billed normally but everything was denied. There was a new code, something to do with NPI. No one else in the group reported they had this same issue...that they knew of.

### **FoCoS Pilot Program:**

Tracy mentioned that they have had minimal errors with the pilot program; she encourages other provider agencies to try it. The group agrees that we need a presentation on this pilot program, especially if it will be the only way to submit billing in the near future. Angelique will email Guadalupe and make this request.

### **CMS Amendment:**

The amendment was submitted to CMS (Sept. 30<sup>th</sup>) with the intention of it being retroactive to July 1<sup>st</sup>. We are awaiting approval on the amendment and the possibility of a mass adjustment. Submission was due to CMS on September 23<sup>rd</sup>.

### **PALCO spending report:**

There has not been any movement on this. Tracy is sending a list of request to state partners via the ACQ. Tracy will send the list of topics to Angelique so that they can be tracked in this committee. There was a FoCoS representative at the MVAC meeting. MVAC did announce the introduction of two different types of EOR roles – volunteer and paid (independent contractor). MVAC is the only committee that knows what is written at this time.

### **Other Topics of Conversation:**

- Melanie's role has not been filled yet. Vangie Yanez and Juanita Salas is no longer with DDSD.

- Advocacy Partner DDSD Provider meeting – next Friday, 11/22, in Santa Fe. It is also virtual. This meeting came from the DDSD Provider Summit with the HCA and the Governor. Angelique noticed that the invite is now open to all Provider Agencies.
