# Fun easy recipes:

#### **Cheese Fries**

Makes 8 servings

Total time to make: 20 minutes

#### Ingredients:

- 1 package (28 ounces) frozen steak fries
- 1 can (10-3/4 ounces) condensed cheddar cheese soup, undiluted
- 1/4 cup 2% milk
- 1/2 teaspoon garlic powder
- 1/4 teaspoon onion powder
- Paprika

#### Directions:

- 1. Heat oven to 450 degrees
- 2. Grease 2- 15x10 baking pans.
- 3. Arrange the steak fries in a single layer on each pan
- 4. Bake for 15-18 minutes or until tender and golden brown.
- 5. In a small saucepan, combine the:
  - a. Soup,
  - b. Milk
  - c. Garlic powder
  - d. Onion powder
- 6. Heat mixture
- 7. Drizzle cheese sauce over the fries
- 8. Sprinkle with paprika.

#### **Lunch Box Pizzas**

Makes 10 servings

Total time to make: 20 minutes

#### Ingredients:

- 1 tube (7-1/2 ounces) refrigerated buttermilk biscuits (10 biscuits)
- 1/4 cup tomato sauce
- 1 teaspoon Italian seasoning
- 10 slices pepperoni
- 3/4 cup shredded Monterey Jack cheese

### Directions:

- 1. Preheat oven to 425 degrees.
- 2. Flatten each biscuit into a 3-in. circle
- 3. Press biscuit into a greased muffin cup.
- 4. Combine the:
  - a. Tomato sauce
  - b. Italian seasoning
- 5. Spoon 1 teaspoonful into each cup.
- 6. Top each with:
  - a. A slice of pepperoni
  - b. 1 tablespoon of cheese.

Bake for 10-15 minutes.
