NMPRC invites residents to weigh in on proposed sale of PNM

ALBUQUERQUE – The New Mexico Public Regulation Commission (NMPRC) is holding a [public hearing](#) to gather feedback on the proposed sale of Public Service Company of New Mexico (PNM) to Blackstone Infrastructure. This is an opportunity for New Mexicans to share input on this matter with the Commission, which will ultimately decide if the acquisition is in the public interest. The Commission will accept comments in-person and virtually at the hearing.

WHEN: Thursday, February 5, 2026, from 4-7 p.m.

WHAT: In August 2025, PNM and TXNM Energy Inc. formally requested approval from the NMPRC to be acquired by Troy ParentCo LLC, a subsidiary of Blackstone Infrastructure. If this proposal is approved, Troy will become the new owner of PNM. The Commission is now inviting residents to share their perspectives on the sale before a final decision is made.

WHERE: Clifford Plaza, 4100 Osuna Road NE, 1st Floor, in Albuquerque. The hearing will also be streamed live on the NMPRC's [YouTube channel](#).
