IRRIGATION SERVICE
(Schedule "IRR")

AVAILABILITY:

Available for service to irrigation pumps within the Utility's service area.

CHARACTER OF SERVICE:

Alternating current, single and/or three phase, 60 Hertz, at available secondary voltages.

NET RATE PER BILLING PERIOD: (or part thereof/service)

\$10.00 per horsepower per year payable in advance (See below) X
-PLUS- X
All kWh per billing period @ \$.11/kWh

MINIMUM ANNUAL CHARGES - PAYABLE IN ADVANCE:

Minimum system charges of \$10.00 per horsepower per year, but no less than \$100.00 per year, shall be charged for each irrigation motor service under this schedule. Such charges shall be payable at the beginning of the calendar year or at such time that a new irrigation service is established or an existing service is re-established. These charges shall be in addition to the above energy rate and no power usage shall be allowed in the system charge. This charge shall cover costs of providing electric service, including operating and maintenance of facilities, consumer accounting expenses and other administrative costs. X X

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DETERMINATION OF HORSEPOWER:

The horsepower for minimum annual charge purposes shall be the motor manufacturer's nameplate rating of horsepower output, except that if the Utility so elects, it shall be determined by actual measurements of power input during a period of maximum normal use less an allowance of 10% of input for motor losses.

TAX ADJUSTMENT:

Billing under this schedule may be increased by an amount equal to the sum of the taxes payable under the Gross Receipts and Compensating Tax Act and of all other taxes, fees, or charges (exclusive of Ad Valorem, State and Federal Income Taxes) payable by the Utility and levied or assessed by any governmental authority on the public utility service rendered, or on the right or privilege of rendering the service, or on any object or event incidental to the rendition of the service.

DEBT COST ADJUSTMENT:

The Utility shall flow through to the users such increases or decreases in debt cost in accordance with 17.9.540.16 NMAC.

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FUEL AND PURCHASED POWER COST ADJUSTMENT:

The Utility shall, if the purchased power expense is increased or decreased above or below the base purchased power cost of \$.0741827/kWh sold, flow through to the users such increases or decreases, in accordance with 17.9.550.12 NMAC.

LATE PAYMENT CHARGE:

A late payment charge of one and one-half percent (1 1/2%) per billing period or fraction thereof will be charged on all utility service bills and invoices which are delinquent per the provisions of the tariff.

TERMS OF PAYMENT:

All bills are net and payable within 20 days from the date of bill.

BILLING PERIOD:

The billing period shall be approximately 1/12 of a year but not necessarily a calendar month.

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CONDITIONS OF SERVICE:

- (1) The Utility's Rules and Regulations, filed with the regulatory body shall apply.
- (2) All wiring, pole lines and other electrical equipment electrically on the load side of the metering point shall be considered the distribution system of the consumer and shall be furnished and maintained by the consumer.
- (3) The consumer's installation shall conform to City, State, and National Electrical Codes and Electrical Safety Codes.
- (4) The consumer shall not resell or share electric service with others.
- (5) Special conditions of service shall be covered by contract.

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
