NMPRC to hold meet-and-greet during visit to Corona

SANTA FE – The New Mexico Public Regulation Commission (NMPRC) will be holding a meet-and-greet at the village hall building in Corona on Monday, June 16. The event aims to introduce commissioners and other agency staff to members of the public and other stakeholders in and around the village. This will be the Commission's first visit to the area since becoming an appointed body two years ago.

During the visit, commissioners and agency staff will also tour the site of the forthcoming nearby SunZia Wind and Transmission Project, a 3.5-gigawatt wind farm located in Lincoln, Torrance, and San Miguel counties, expected to be completed next year.

This visit is a part of the NMPRC's goal to increase public accessibility and outreach in communities beyond the Santa Fe-Albuquerque corridor.
