

Instructions for Registering a Notary Public Official Stamp

- 1. As soon as your application is approved and you have received your Certificate of Commission you must purchase an official stamp.
- 2. The stamp must be in 10 point font, contain "State of New Mexico", "Notary Public", your legal name identically as listed on your Certificate of Commission, the issued commission number and the commission expiration date as listed on your Certificate of Commission. See below example.
- 3. The stamp **cannot** contain the New Mexico state seal.
- **4.** The attached Notary Public Stamp Registration form must be submitted to the Office of the Secretary of State within <u>45 days</u> of your Certificate of Commission being issued. Failure to do so will result in a referral to the State Ethics Commission.

Notary Public Official Stamp Registration

You **shall** provide proof of your issued stamp within 45 days of your notary application being processed. All information provided on your stamp must be an exact match to the issued Certificate of Commission.
