### New Mexico Safe at Home



An Address Confidentiality Program Helping Survivors of Domestic Abuse Live Safe, Fulfilling Lives



### WHAT is Safe at Home?

The Secretary of State's *Safe at Home* program is an address confidentiality program. It allows survivors of domestic violence, sexual assault or stalking to receive mail using the Secretary of State's address as a substitute for their own, while keeping their actual address confidential.

#### Substitute Address

The *Safe at Home* program assigns participants a substitute address that can be used with all city, county, and state offices as well as with private organizations that require a mailing address. Your physical address will not appear on public records.

#### **Mail Forwarding Service**

First-class mail will be securely handled and forwarded to the participant's confidential address.

#### Confidential Voter Registration

Participants can register to vote without having their information posted on the public voter registration list. Participation in the *Safe at Home* program allows eligible voters to apply to vote as an absentee voter.

# Who is <u>ELIGIBLE</u> for *Safe at Home*?

Participants in the Secretary of State's *Safe at Home* program are:

- Residents of New Mexico
- Survivors of domestic violence, sexual assault, attempted sexual assault, or stalking
