SANTA FE – The New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) District Five is holding a State Transportation Commission (STC) Meeting in northwest New Mexico on Thursday, August 18, at 8:30 a.m. at the Farmington Civic Center 200 W Arrington Street Farmington, New Mexico 87401.

District Three: Commissioner Hilma Chynoweth

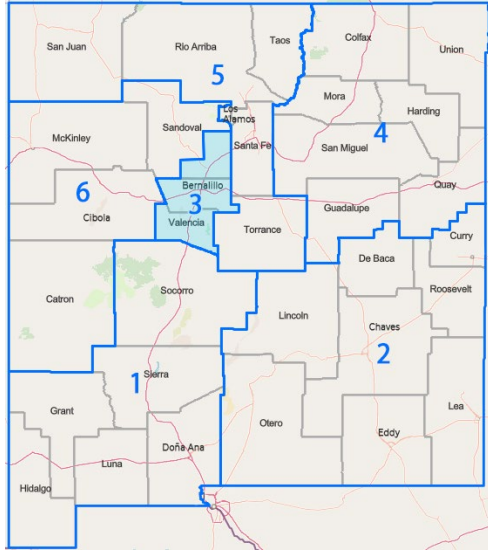
District Four: Commissioner Walter Adams, Chairman
