SANTA FE – The New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) District Two is holding a State Transportation Commission (STC) Meeting in Hobbs on Thursday, Nov. 18 at 8 a.m. at the Center of Recreational Excellence (CORE), located at 4827 N Lovington Highway.

The department holds six STC meetings annually. One held in each of the six department districts with one commissioner appointed by the governor to represent each district.

The Transportation Commission sets department policy and oversees the use of the State Road Fund.
