RE: I-10 & I-40 Planning Funds

Metropolitan and Regional Transportation Planning Organizations:

The Department of Transportation is soliciting applications for Planning Funds to be used along the I-10 and I-40 corridors. The funds are eligible to all Local and Tribal entities and all 5 eligible NMDOT districts. Eligible projects are in the following categories: (1) Planning along the I-10 and I-40 Corridors.

The Projects will be vetted through the General Office based on the following project prioritization criteria:

- 1. Planning: Is this project identified as a priority on a local or regional planning or programming document? Is this project consistent with local or regional plans?
- 2. Project: Does the project integrate multimodal safety? Does the project integrate community economic development?
- 3. Project readiness: If awarded, will the applicant be able to start spending the money within 6 months from receiving the fully executed project agreement?
- 4. Funding: If awarded, are there any other funds committed to this project?

The application package shall include the following:

- 1. Cover letter application including: (1) brief overview of project including prioritization criteria 1 & 2; (2) the timeframe in which the potential grantee is prepared to spend the funds, if received (project readiness); and (3) verification that funding requested will be enough to complete the phase of work submitted.
- 2. Project Feasibility Form (PFF) signed by District representative if the project does not have a signed PFF, then the potential grantee must work with your office on the PFF.
- 3. Resolution of Sponsorship from their governing body.
- 4. Map of project location including mile posts; and
- 5. A letter of support from owners of the right-of-way, which includes getting a letter from the District if the project is partially or fully within NMDOT right-of-way.

This is a one-time solicitation. All federal processes must be followed and will be disclosed on grant agreements. Federal guidelines may be found on the NMDOT website under Business Support, T/LPA Documents and Information, T/LPA Handbook for Federal Projects. The funds will be reimbursement and must be fully expended by June 30, 2024.
