



## ***Rider Alert: Seeking Public input on adding a stop to the Santa Fe Place Shuttle***

### **Public Comment Period June 10, 2025 through July 10, 2025**

Beginning Tuesday, June 10, 2025, the NMDOT Park and Ride is soliciting public comments on a proposal to add a stop on Las Soleras Drive to the Santa Fe Place Shuttle.

The inclusion of a new stop on Las Soleras on Santa Fe Place Shuttle would entail time adjustments to all Northbound and Southbound trips.

The proposed Schedule changes are as follows:

- The morning Northbound Santa Fe Place shuttle stops from NM-599 to the Presbyterian Hospital & VA Clinic will remain as currently scheduled.
- The first morning shuttle will depart Las Soleras Dr. at 6:48am, Cristos at 6:54am and Santa Fe Place at 6:57am.
- The second morning shuttle will depart Las Soleras Dr. at 7:59am, Cristos at 8:05am and Santa Fe Place at 8:10am.
- The final morning shuttle will depart Las Soleras Dr. at 9:07am, Cristos at 9:13am and Santa Fe Place at 9:18am.
- The afternoon Southbound Santa Fe Place shuttle stops from the New Mexican Plaza stop to the NM-599 stop will remain as currently scheduled.
- The first afternoon shuttle will depart Santa Fe Place at 3:58pm, Cristos at 4:02pm, Presbyterian Hospital at 4:06pm and Las Soleras Dr. at 4:12pm
- The second afternoon shuttle will depart Santa Fe Place at 4:45pm, Cristos at 4:49pm, Presbyterian Hospital at 4:55pm and Las Soleras Dr. at 4:59pm
- The final afternoon shuttle will depart Santa Fe Place at 5:08pm, Cristos at 5:12pm, Nexus at 5:19pm, Presbyterian Hospital at 5:23pm and Las Soleras Dr. at 5:27pm.

NMDOT Park and Ride's Santa Fe Shuttle routes operate on all weekdays, except the following designated state holidays: New Years Day, Martin Luther King Day, Memorial Day, Juneteenth, July 4, Labor Day, Columbus Day, Veterans Day, Thanksgiving Day, the Friday following Thanksgiving, and Christmas Day. Exceptions: Designated state holidays that fall on a Saturday will be observed on Friday and those that fall on a Sunday will be observed on Monday.

**Connections with NM Rail Runner Express**

*Santa Fe Place Shuttles* are scheduled to connect with three morning northbound arriving and three afternoon/evening southbound departing NM Rail Runner Express trains at the NM-599 Station.

*Rodeo Park Shuttles* are scheduled to meet three morning northbound arriving and three afternoon/evening southbound departing NM Rail Runner Express trains at the South Capitol Station.

*Purple Route Shuttles* meet the northbound early morning bus from Albuquerque only, and proceed to the South Capitol Station and transfer to Red Route across the platform for the Santa Fe Depot from the NM-599 Station.

*National Guard/Corrections Shuttles* are scheduled to meet with three morning northbound arriving and three afternoon/evening southbound departing NM Rail Runner Express trains at the NM-599 Station.

*Anaya Complex Shuttles* are scheduled to meet with three morning northbound arriving and three afternoon/evening southbound departing NM Rail Runner Express trains at the South Capitol Station.
